

Integration training for immigrants

Target group

The training is intended for immigrants who are currently unemployed or at risk of becoming unemployed.

Objective

The objective of the training is to learn Finnish language, achieving the skill level B1.1. In addition, the aim is to find a suitable job or a place to study. The participants will obtain a sufficient language level, as well as the necessary social, cultural and life skills for surviving in everyday life, searching independently for a job or a place to study and becoming fully integrated members of the Finnish society. The training lasts approximately one year.

Content

- Introduction and personalized study plan
- Reading and writing skills
- Finnish language and communication skills
- Working life and social skills
- Personal guidance
- Vocational training (6 weeks)

- Job search coaching
- Plans for future studies and / or employment

Our way of training

Our teaching and working methods are versatile and practical. Integration training contains, in addition to classroom teaching, visits to educational institutions, potential employers and social services. Training is organized both as in-person and online courses.

We are following Basics of the Finnish National Agency for Education's curriculum for integration training.
