



Multilingual social orientation online for immigrants

Multilingual social orientation is a service that supports integration and other services, helping immigrants gain a broader picture of Finnish society and become more involved in its activities more quickly.

Eezy Työllisyyspalvelut, in collaboration with PopRova, organizes non-stop online group courses on the easy-to-use and interactive Teams platform. There can be 8–25 participants in a group, allowing individual questions to be discussed.

PopRova comprises 4 employment areas and their municipalities:

- Oulu region employment area
- Raahe employment area
- Rova region employment area
- Ylivieska, Kalajoki, Nivala employment area

Eezy's social orientation instructor is a person who is fluent in both the language of instruction and Finnish and who is also very familiar with Finnish society, the service system, and culture.

Visitors and dialogicity, i.e. the opportunity to ask questions and discuss module themes, support learning and strengthen customer involvement and agency.

The teaching uses online downloadable social orientation learning materials prepared by the Finnish Refugee Aid and the Finnish National Board of Education, adapted to the needs of each study group.
